It is difficult to be sure, but as I told one of the coaches, every day I wait for financial assistance either through grants or corporate contributions another child may choose to travel down the wrong path.

The lot on 24th & Federal is large enough to place a regulation size soccer field on. Last year when Soccer On State removed debris from part of it, leveled the ground with top soil and laid sod over 3/4 of the land remained unkept. On Tuesday when the Director of Streets and Sanitation attended the Kick-Off he was so impressed by what he saw that he promised Jim Moody and me that he would send in a team to cut weeds, remove debris and cut the remaining lot. Today a team showed up and after one year Soccer On State continues to make a difference.
